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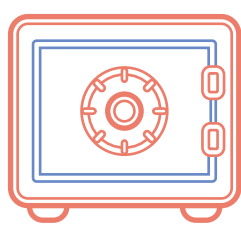
Energy efficiency

It's made-to-measure design helps to reduce external sounds, which is particularly useful for houses in the city where the surrounding area can get very noisy.

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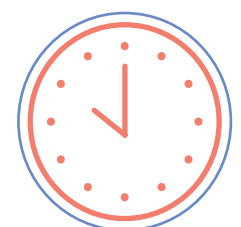
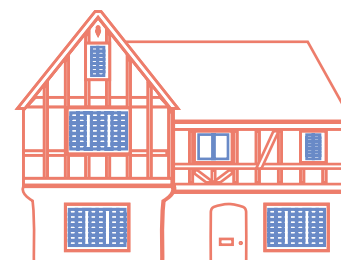
Increased security

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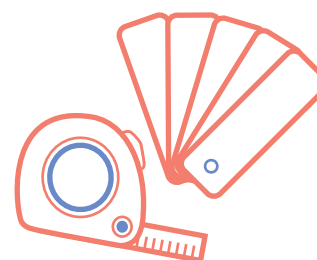
Low maintenance

The glazing can be fitted in a variety of different types of window, such as both square and faceted bay windows.

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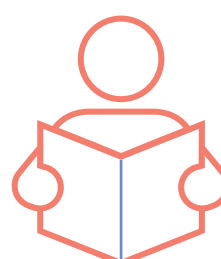
Cost-effective

Simply fitting into your existing windows, secondary double glazing provides an affordable alternative to replacing all of the windows in your home.

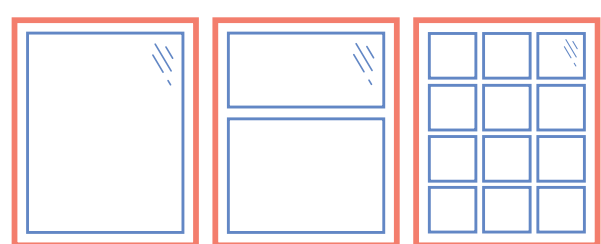
No planning permission is required

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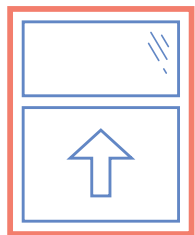
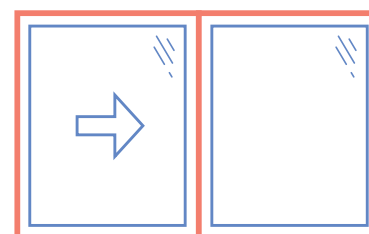
White aluminium frame

Designed to fit existing vertical sliding windows or to give access to top hung casement sashes

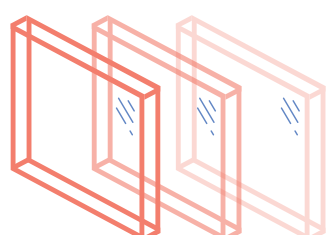
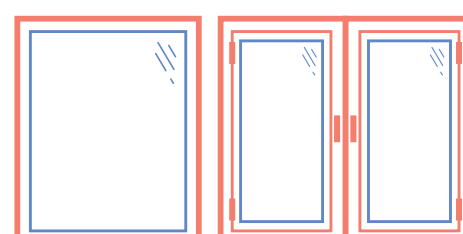
Hinged and fixed panes
