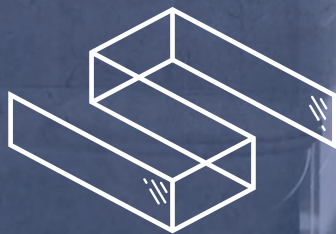

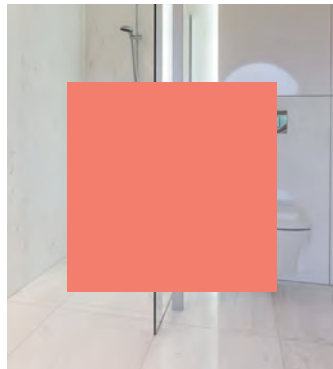


SHOWER SCREEN / ENCLOSURE OPTIONS

Whether you know exactly which design you are looking for or you are open to ideas, it's important to research the different styles of shower screens and enclosures available to you.

Walk-In Shower

With no door, the walk-in shower is spacious and usually consists of one or two shower screens.



Recess Cubicles

This features three solid walls with a door to gain access in and out of the shower.



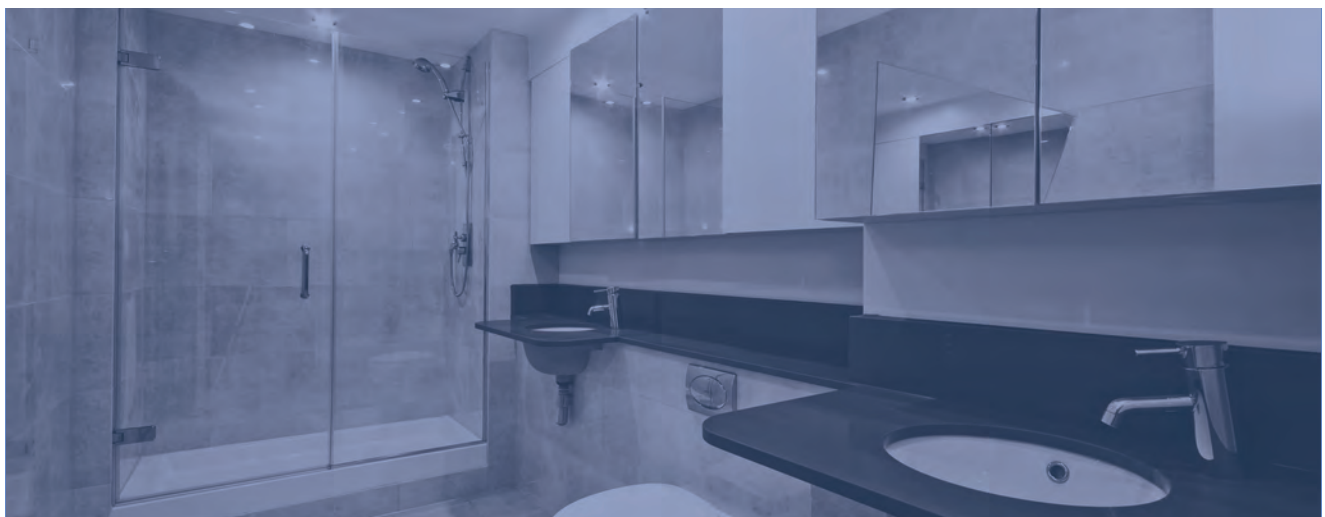
Classic Shower Cubicle

A popular choice in many households, this type of enclosure usually has one single hinged door.



Bath Shower Screen

As a far more hygienic, tidier alternative to a shower curtain, a bath shower screen is one panel of glass that sits on the edge of the bath.





Layout

Prior to having anything fitted, you should carefully consider the layout of your bathroom as this could influence the style of shower screen or enclosure you choose. You will need to take into account:

- The size, shape and height of the enclosure or bath
- The location of the windows, lights and doors
- The extra space required to open and close the shower door if applicable
- Whether your enclosure needs to open to the left or right due to any obstructions

WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN BUYING A SHOWER SCREEN

Preparation is key when choosing a new shower screen to ensure you find a fully functional design which fits the measurements of your bathroom and suits your individual style.

Types Of Glass

When it comes to the design of the glass, there are a variety of types to choose from:

Clear Glass

A traditional choice in many homes.

Obscured/frosted glass

Textured glass and sandblasting helps to improve privacy levels.

Decorative/patterned glass

Etched shower screens create a stunning, opulent feature in the bathroom.

The glass used for the shower screen will need to be toughened to withstand changes in temperature and ensure complete safety should it shatter. It's worth noting that this prevents the glass from being cut again in future, so it's important that all of the measurements are one-hundred percent correct.

Style Of Bathroom

Thickness Of Glass

Glass thickness is an important consideration when buying a new shower door or enclosure, as the thicker the glass, the safer and more robust it will be. You have a choice of 6mm, 8mm and 10mm thick glass panels, all of which have a sleek, polished appearance with varying levels of durability.

Colours

When it comes to the colour of your shower screen, clear glass is an original choice, however, you may decide to get creative with various colours or patterns. Our customers can choose from the RAL colour chart to find the perfect shade which complements their bathroom decor.

Fittings And Fixtures

Fixtures and fittings on shower doors and enclosures can provide the perfect finishing touch to your bathroom. Your choice of shower components can transform style and functionality within your bathroom, from chrome plated handles to magnetic seals.

You must carefully consider the wall fixings you use - such as brackets and hinges - to ensure the glass is securely attached to your wall, floor, tiles or other glass panels.



MEASURING GUIDE

When measuring up for a new shower screen, it's important to make the most of all available space. Ordering a shower screen requires accurate measurements to be taken for the glass prior to purchasing anything.

Shower Enclosure

Measure the showering area, including the shower tray or wet room floor, wall tiles and height of the bathroom

Take into account any windows or light fittings which may be in the way

Remember to measure the surrounding area as certain styles, such as hinged doors, will require enough space for the door to open with ease without hitting anything

Make sure the showering area is fully tiled prior to ordering the bespoke glass to ensure everything is exactly how it will be when the screen is fitted

Shower In The Bath

Measurements for the glass should only be taken once all of the waterproofing, grouting and tiles are fitted

Measure the height of the showering area, as well as the edge of the bath where the panel of glass will sit

Take into account any obstructions on the wall which may affect the fitting process

Top Tip

A major benefit of bespoke shower screens is that the glass can be cut to the exact measurements required, which is particularly useful if you choose an unusual shape to ensure the perfect fit.



FAQs

Q Do you offer a measuring service?

A We will visit your property and take accurate measurements of your showering area if you have accepted our quote and are completely happy to proceed. If you don't need us to fit the shower screen for you, we don't tend to come out to measure up.

Q Do you offer tinted glass for shower screens?

A We offer grey or brown tinted glass in 6mm and 10mm thicknesses.

Q Do you offer any guarantees?

A We offer a 3 year guarantee on product failure, however this does not cover accidental damage or breakages.

Q Do you offer delivery and fitting?

A Yes, we offer a prompt, efficient delivery and fitting service for all of our shower screens - take a look at our map to see which areas we deliver to. It's worth noting that a delivery driver is different to a glazier, so please let us know if you require a fitting service from us when ordering and we will send the appropriate people out to you.

Q Do you offer patterned glass for shower screens?

A Our shower screens are available in a range of modern and traditional patterns, depending on your requirements. These can be custom etched to provide you with a personalised shower screen tailored to your tastes.





MAINTENANCE

As you close your eyes to enjoy a refreshing shower, it can be easy to overlook how messy your shower screens have become. Adding this quick and easy task to your cleaning regime will ensure you maintain a hygienic, tidy bathroom, which is particularly important if you are expecting guests!

Apply your bathroom cleaner using the directions on the bottle

2

Rinse your shower screen and wipe with a sponge or cloth to remove excess grime and soap scum

3

Use a streak-free glass cleaner or a mixture of white vinegar and water to polish the glass

Top Tip

Avoid using abrasive cleaning products or harsh scourers as these can scratch and damage the glass

We can also supply you with a surface protector that seals and protects glass, mirrors and ceramics. Directions for this protector are as follows:

1

Clean and dry the surface to be treated

2

Apply the protector and massage it into the surface by wiping with a cloth using a firm circular and overlapping motion until clear

3

For initial treatment, reapply to ensure complete coverage

4

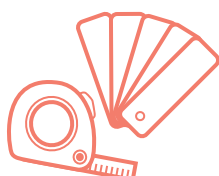
Remove any excess polymer by sprinkling the surface with water and wipe with a dry cloth or paper towel until clear and sparkling. **Reapply whenever the water stops beading.**
